Description This tool consists of one school's continuous improvement cycle and includes guiding questions and an outline of the steps in their process. This diagram can help school community members visualize the on-going, systematic approach used by an advanced grantee to grow and improve their SLC implementation. The process described takes place in teacher teams, schools-within-the-school, the school leadership team, and the school council. By constantly focusing efforts through the lens of data and assessment, this school keeps teachers and school staff thinking about improvement and meeting the needs of students every day.

Instructions & Considerations

This tool may help you to:

- Focus planning efforts in order to arrive at a continuous, thoroughgoing method of improvement
- Help teachers and school staff visualize and put into practice the theory behind continuous improvement
- Assist stakeholders in understanding how the SLC program will evolve to better meet student needs

When applying this tool to your setting you may want to consider the following:

- Aligning current school plans (including professional development and school improvement plans)
- Aligning or coordinating with district initiatives to avoid "reinventing the wheel"
- Identifying resources that may be available or need to be sought to arrive at a continuous system of improvement
