Meaningful SLC Goal Statements

Meaningful SLC goals are broad statements based on identified need that reflect a vision and describe long-term changes you want to accomplish. Goal statements should be powerful - you should be able to remember them! TASK - With the SLC leadership team:

- (1) Go through your SLC grant proposal and identify your major SLC goal statements. List them on the worksheet below.
- (2) Evaluate the goal statement based on the criteria. Rewrite your SLC goal statement, if needed, to adhere to the criteria.
- (3) Make sure to identify the need this goal is addressing.
- (4) Develop two to five goal statements. Have two to three student outcome goals and one to two program implementation goals.
